DIRECTIONS

To the Fair Lawn Community Center:

From New York City: George Washington Bridge to Route 4 West. Continue to Route 208 North. Exit at Fair Lawn Avenue East. Make a right onto 20th Street and follow to the end of the road.

From South or North: Route 287 North or South to Route 208 South. Exit at Fair Lawn Avenue. Continue straight through light at end of ramp onto Orchard Street. Make a left onto Berdan Avenue and continue to end. Make a right onto 20th Street.

From West: Route 80 East to Route 20 North. Exit at Fair Lawn Avenue. Make a right onto Orchard Street. Make a left onto Berdan Avenue and continue to end. Make a right onto 20th Street.

To the Hyatt Place of Fair Lawn/Paramus:

From the Garden State Parkway North: Take Parkway North to Exit 160. Turn left at the bottom of Exit and follow signs for Route 4 West. Take the entrance to Route 4 West. The hotel is the second building on the right.

From the Garden State Parkway South: Take the Garden State Parkway South to Exit 163 (Route 17/South Paramus). Take Route 17 South to Route 4 West (Paterson) Stay in the right lane at all times. The hotel is on the right, before the junction for Route 208 North (Oakland).

From Route 17 North or South: Take Route 17 to Route 4 West (Paterson). Stay in the right hand lane at all times. The hotel is on the right, before the junction for Route 208 North (Oakland).

From Route 208 South: Take Route 208 South to Route 4 East to Paramus Road North Exit. Drive on Paramus Road to Route 4 West. The hotel is the second building on the right.

From New York City via the George Washington Bridge: Take the George Washington Bridge to Route 4 West (Paramus). Take Route 4 West for approximately 10 miles. The hotel is on the right, before the junction for Route 208 North (Oakland).

From New York City via the Lincoln Tunnel: Exit the tunnel and follow signs for Route 3 West (Secaucus) to Route 17 North (Rutherford/Paramus). Take Route 17 North for approximately 10 miles to Route 4 West (Paterson). On Route 4 West, The hotel is on the right, before the junction for Route 208 North (Oakland).

From the Hyatt Place to the Fair Lawn Community Center:

Route 4 West. Continue to Route 208 North. Exit at Fair Lawn Avenue East. Make a right onto 20th Street and follow to the end of the road.

From the Fair Lawn Community Center to the Hyatt Place:

20th Street to Fair Lawn Avenue. Turn right onto Fair Lawn Avenue. At the fourth traffic light make a right onto Paramus Road. Continue on Paramus Road and take entrance ramp onto Route 4 West. The hotel is located approximately 500 feet on your right.
